
Vacation Bible School





MISSIONS OUTREACH UPDATE



Thank you to all who are giving your Faith Promise pledges! In the month of April we had \$14,412 given towards missions for our church. We spent \$18,707 as we paid our 2nd quarterly payments to our mission partners. We were able to bless Sharol Shutts, one of our mission partners, with a Faith Promise scholarship for her to travel to Brazil on a short-term mission.

The Young Adult Mission to Guatemala planning is going great. There are 16 persons going to work at Escuela Integrada in Antigua, Guatemala. The school is currently serving 170 students and has 25 teachers and employees. Students' ages range from kindergarten through 9th grade. Please keep this team in your prayers as they continue preparing this month for their trip. Prayers for God to work in their lives and the lives God puts into their paths. Prayers for safety and protection in their travels and on the ground. The trip is June 8 - 14.

One of our new mission partners are Rob and Shini Abraham. They are involved with SonScape Retreats. These retreats are for Pastors, Missionaries or anyone in ministry especially in places around the world where there are few resources available. The Abrahams lead these retreats to provide desperately needed soul care and pastoral care to the ones who are in need. The ministry was started in 2014 and there have been 45+ retreats with more than 30 nationalities. They say many in ministry feel lonely, overly burdened, overworked and face burn out. The retreats give encouragement, time for refreshment and rest, and provide a safe place to process. Many who attend say they feel better equipped to serve again in their communities. Keep the Abrahams and SonScape Retreats in your prayers as God meets these persons where it is most needed in their lives.
