
# THE CALLING







"Let us examine our ways and test them and let us return to the Lord."
~Lamentations 3:40 NIV

This past Wednesday we celebrated Ash Wednesday. For our noon and 6 pm services, we totaled around 375 people. Both services were anointed, and I am grateful for our staff that helped us begin our Lenten journey. Here, again, are some terms that are used for the Lenten season:

- Lent is: a period of fasting, moderation, and self-denial traditionally observed by Catholics and some Protestant denominations. It begins with <u>Ash</u> <u>Wednesday</u> and ends with <u>Easter Sunday</u>. The length of the Lenten fast was established in the fourth century as 46 days (40 days, not counting Sundays).
- Ash Wednesday is: a day of repentance, prayer, and fasting, where Christians reflect on their mortality and seek forgiveness for their sins.
- The Palms that were waved last year in the Palm Sunday processional are the ashes that we used for ashes this past Wednesday.
- The ashes represent our mortality and a call to repent and believe the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

"From dust you came and to dust you shall return.

"Repent and believe the Gospel"

The sign that will be imposed upon our foreheads is the sign of the cross.
 "1 Corinthians 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God."

Even if we have observed Lent for many years, this time is a moment of grace that God gives us, as His children, to ask the Holy Spirit to examine our hearts and lives. Our goal is to dig in and seek the Lord's heart and face in such a way that when we gather on Easter Sunday, our hearts will be full of gratitude for all that the Triune God has done for us throughout this Lenten season. May we observe and practice a Holy Lent.....

Rev. Fuxia Wang and the International Ministry at OU Wesley has been a mission partner with First Methodist Church for many years. She sent highlights of the Fall semester and I wanted to share with you.

The International Ministries continue to thrive as we practice radical hospitality to the international students' community at OU. Here are some ministry highlights of CONNECT, INVEST & SERVE & TRANSFORM:

- Thanks be to God for a wonderful and fruitful campus outreach during the New International Students Orientation & Resource Fair on the OU campus in August 2024, meeting and welcoming 300 new international students from 30 countries and 5 continents. The harvest is plentiful. God is good!
- We took a total of 27 different students on hiking trips to OKC Cowboy
  Museum, a Chinatown grocery trip and Hefner Lake hiking trip with wonderful
  fellowship time. 139 (over 20% increase from 107 in 2023) different students
  attended our weekly worship & Bible study so far this semester. This semester
  worship & Bible study is focused on being a follower of Christ through Leaning

on the Everlasting Arms through prayer and being faithful in doing small things and expect multiplication of God's grace. In total, so far, we've ministered to 184 different students from over 21 countries through our weekly worship, Bible study, ESL class, monthly trips and special outreach events. "Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn." (Isaiah 60:3) God is good! May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine on us—so that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations.

- Our children's ministry has returned and continues to grow at the Wesley. The children's Bible study program starts at 6 pm on Thursday evenings to be followed by dinner at 6:30pm. A unique aspect of our ministry is the active involvement of parents and grandparents. This intergenerational approach not only enriches the learning experience but also strengthens the bonds within our church family. It's a beautiful sight to see different generations coming together, united in their faith and eagerness to learn. It's a perfect opportunity for spiritual growth and community bonding. Let's nurture the next generation together. "Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old, he will not depart from it." (Proverbs 22:6) We invite you to join us in shaping our children's future through continuous prayers and support.
- 112 people joined us for our annual International Cultural Night with dinner and a talent show to celebrate the uniqueness and diversity represented at Wesley and OU campus on November 20. Also, we had a Christmas worship with love feast on December 5. We gave away dozens of Christmas gifts to the children and students and we finished this semester better and stronger with a heart full of thanksgiving & faith, hope, love & joy. God is good!

Please keep this ministry and mission in your prayers as International students go back to their countries and share the love of Jesus to their family and friends.

# REPORT FROM ETHIOPIA

#### Rev. John Hollon and Holly Joy



Rev. John Hollon serves as the lead for the Heartland Conference missions team. He and Holly Joy had the privilege of traveling to Ethiopia in January (Holly's second trip) on behalf of Heartland Missions. Their purpose was evangelism and pastoral training as we partner with our brothers and sisters in Ethiopia to further God's movement through the Global Methodist Church.

Our partner Conference in Ethiopia is formerly a large group of Nazarene Churches who decided the GMC was the right path for them. As you can imagine, this has been a process for them and we have walked hand in hand through it all.





The bulk of our time was spent in the classroom. We taught four courses including worship and sacraments, Methodist Doctrine & Polity, Methodist History, as well as Church Finance and Administration. We trained over 160 pastors during our weeklong course. Of that group, we recognized 60 Elders who were ordained in the Nazarene Church and ordained 29 new Elders and 1 new Deacon.







Our favorite part was the people. They are so beautiful and faithful to God - it blows you away. They worship with no clock, and it's a beautiful practice of being present with our Creator and Maker. They have such a love for people and God's word that you can tell it's a precious gift not to be take for granted.




